

## Poster Competition Rules and Regulations

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Only one poster per presenting author (graduate students and post-docs only) may be submitted to the poster competition. If the poster author wishes to present more than one poster, the remaining posters must be submitted as non-competition posters.
- 2. Poster Competition Awardees who received awards <u>the last two years in a row</u> are **NOT** eligible to apply again until 2026.
- 3. Posters and abstracts entered into the Poster Competition must be uploaded by **November 6**. Authors are encouraged to bring an updated printed version of their poster to the NFHB Forum.
- 4. The presenting author must be in attendance at the NFHB Forum and be present during their author time of a designated poster session to qualify to win one of the top prizes. If the presenting author is not present the poster will be disqualified.
- 5. There will be two categories for awards: Post-doctoral Researchers and Graduate Students.
- 6. Evaluations: two rounds of judging will occur.
  - a. **Round 1**: Posters and associated abstracts will be evaluated using the Virtual Poster Room for *Research Concept* (Were the objectives clearly stated? Was the project innovative?), *Experimental Quality* (Was the experimental design and method appropriate for the objective(s)? Do the conclusions adequately and concisely interpret the results?), *Display Attributes* (Were the images and text easily read on screen?), and *Overall Poster Quality and Presentation*.
  - b. Round 2: The Top 5 Post-doctoral Researchers and the Top 5 Graduate Student presenting authors will be required to give a presentation during a Poster Competition Session of the National Fusarium Head Blight Forum. Presenters will be given 3 minutes to present in front of all attendees with 1 minute for questions by the judges. Evaluations will take place during these designated Poster Competition Sessions and be based on *Presentation Skills* (Was the author confident, professional and did they convey the research problems, methods and conclusions to their audience?) and *Question and Answer Skills* (Did the presenter answer questions effectively?).
- Poster Awardees will be announced on Monday afternoon of the NFHB Forum prior to the final Poster Session. Award certificates will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in each category.
